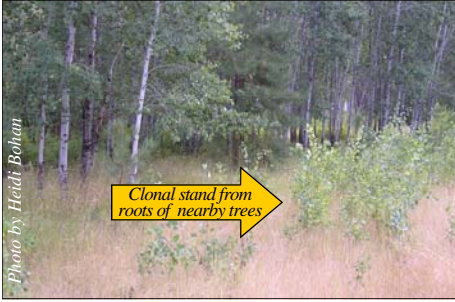


This deciduous tree can grow up to 75' tall, and often occurs in clonal stands from underground roots .

Quaking Aspen *Populus tremuloides*

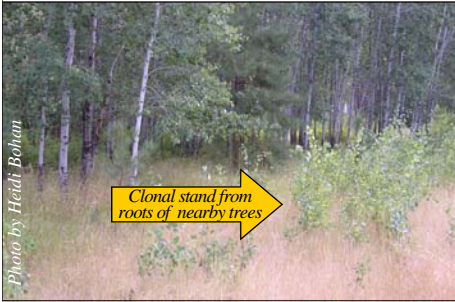
Smooth, waxy bark is distinctively whitish to green-gray. Black branch scars appear to look like eyes.
