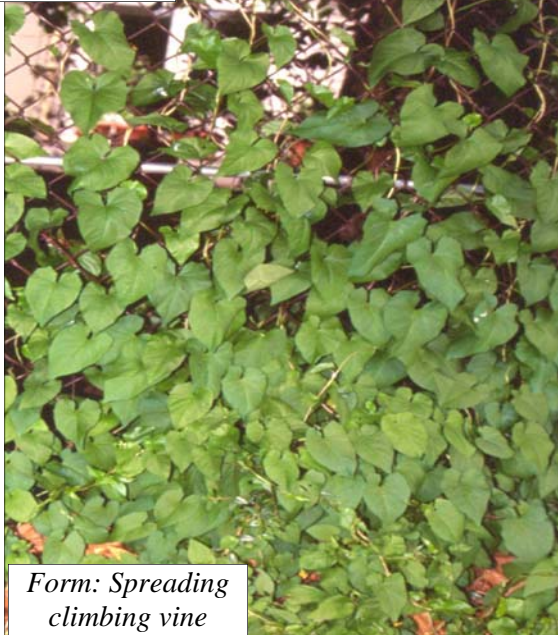


General: Deciduous perennial; 6'-30' long vines



Heart-shaped leaves appear in spring

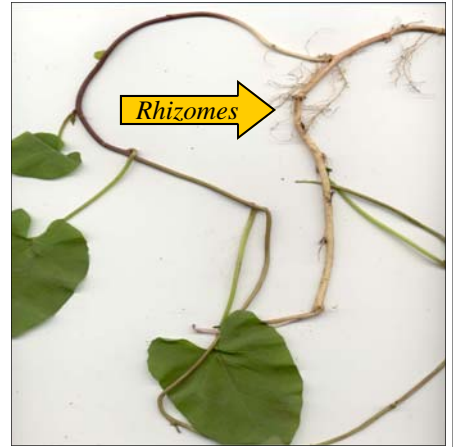


Form: Spreading climbing vine

Management Strategies

- Non-designated noxious weed
- Always remove
- Extensive rhizomatous roots
- Primary spread: Seed, rhizomes



Note: Rhizomes are very persistent. If needed, lift native plants while dormant and remove weed rhizomes from their roots.

Check with parks department or school district for proper disposal.

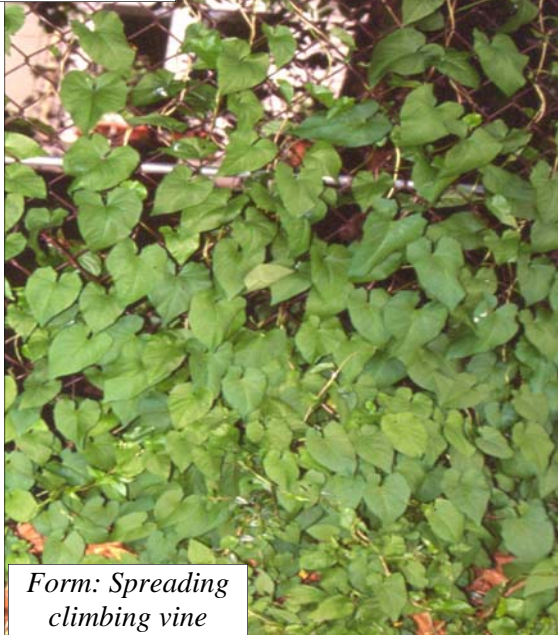

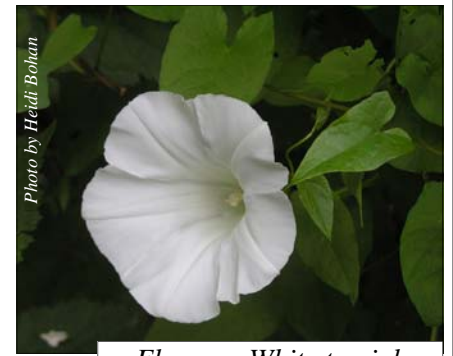
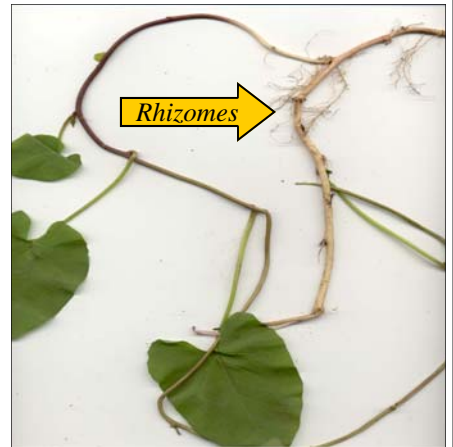
