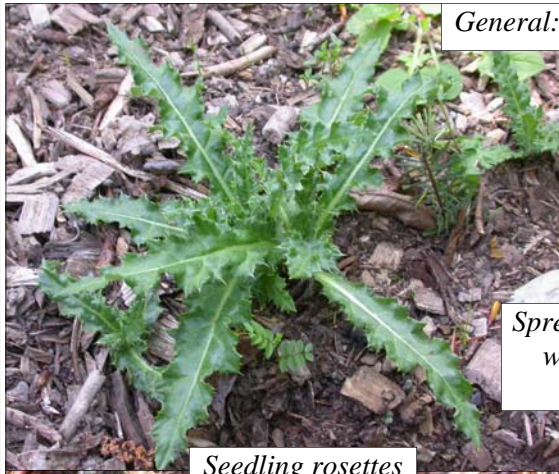


General: Deciduous perennial; up to 8' tall

Roots: Taproot with rhizomes which can be as deep as 22" below the surface

Management Strategies

- Non-designated noxious weed
 - Always remove
 - Taproot: Remove all fragments
 - Primary spread: Seed, rhizomes
- Note: Rhizomes sometimes run as deep as 22"

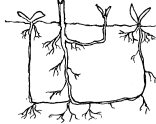
