

General: Perennial; 12"-30" tall



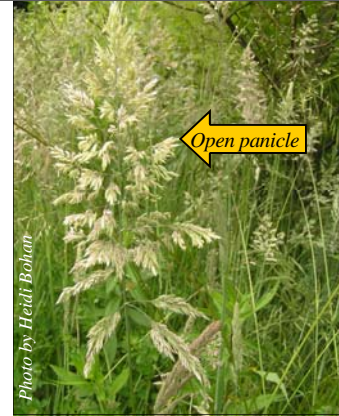
Leaves: Flat, 1/4"-3/8" wide, gray and velvety to hairy; stems also velvety to hairy



Form: Clumping to spreading



Flower/Seedhead: Purplish-tinted tufted spike opens to a branching flower cluster or "panicle."

### Management Strategies

- Fibrous roots: Remove major
- Primary spread: Seed

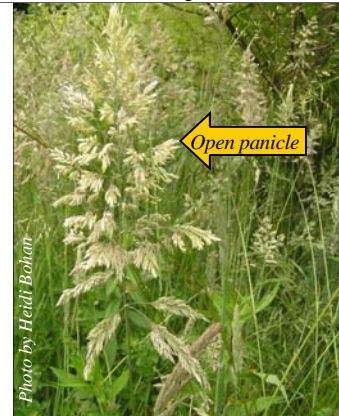

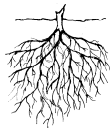
