Skyline Trail

Skyline Trail, Whatcom County, WA. List covers plants found along the Skyline Divide Trail from the trailhead to the point where the trail leaves the timber, including plants found in the parking area.. Skyline Divide is north of Mt. Baker, and the trail may be reached from Highway 542 via FR 39 (one mile east Glacier Public Service Center), then FR 37 (about one-tenth mile on FR 39) and follow to the end (about 20 miles.) List by Jim Duemmel, July/August, 2010. 85 spp.
